You Matter Community Scheme

On a recent high profile leisure sector project, MAC worked closely with the main contractors to embrace the Social Value Action Plan recruitment process as part of our compliant contract delivery.

This included involvement with the 'You Matter Communities' scheme, providing local communities and people with an opportunity to access small grants, volunteer time and unused materials from the construction process.



Employment Support - Aberdeen

This employment session was held with candidates looking for construction work. Members of the ABZWorks team, along with Aberdeen Council staff, also attended the session. Following a group presentation and discussion, we spent time with each individual to discuss their skills, qualifications and job interests.

We had a varied age group in attendance with differing skill sets, so one-to-one conversations were essential to give relevant details to each person.



Materials Donation - Loughborough

Following works carried out at the National Rehabilitation Site in Loughborough, MAC donated excess insulation materials to local farmers situated close to the construction site. This was carried out in conjunction with our social value partner, CLEAR Engagement.

In total MAC donated over £30,000 worth of insulated panels, and arrangements were made for the farmers to come and collect the materials which they will be using to build a new barn.



Interview Advice for Students - Manchester

At this event we provided practice interviews for Year 11 students in conjunction with Our Futures. During these sessions we offered advice on interview techniques and application forms, along with guidance on applying for colleges, universities, work and apprenticeships. .

Following the practice interviews we were able to provide constructive feedback on individuals' particular strengths whilst also suggesting possible improvements they might consider making for their future applications.
